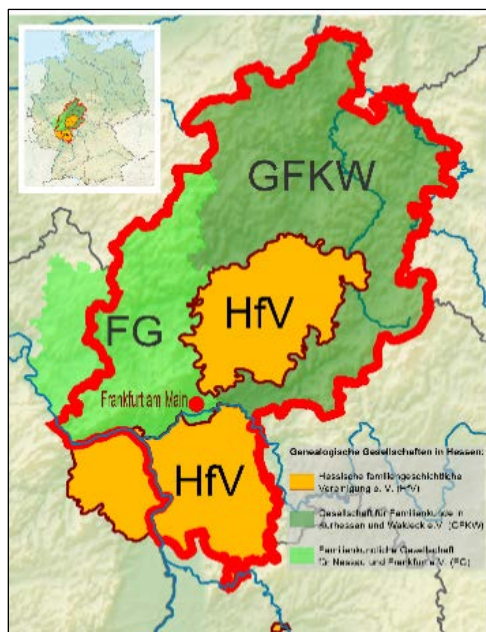

Since the 17th century church books have been systematically kept. In our member area you can find more than 500 000 digitized pages of church book duplicates from the years 1808 – 1875. The scanning of additional books is on-going.

Members have started to transcribe book entries. So the data can be searched and easier used by other members.

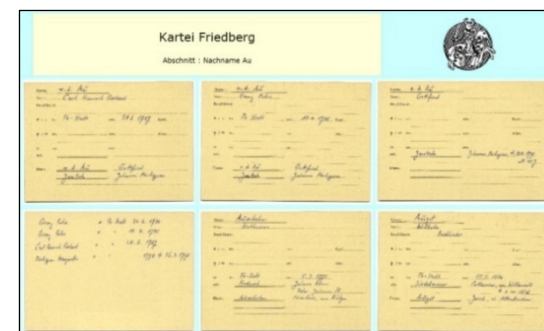


Registry offices of the communities were introduced in the German Empire in 1876.

Church books and official registries are the basis for family search. The data from the sources has been edited and published for many communities. The HfV supports the publication of such area bound family books. We also created a series of 60 books.



In the course of time the HfV has built up an archive from the legacy of personal data of researchers.

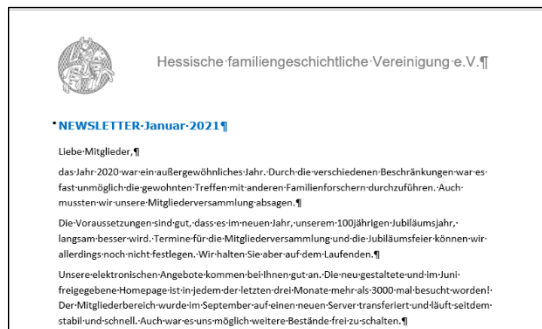


We have digitized and indexed this archive, consisting of more than 500 000 record cards. It is available in the member area.
